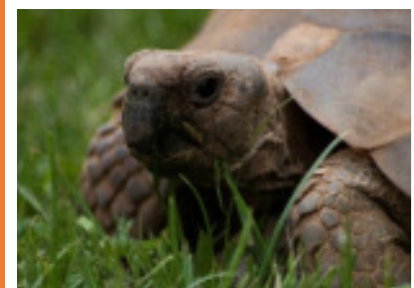
Get up close and personal with some of our charming reptiles and invertebrates while being dazzled by fascinating facts from one of our amazing animal experts.
